## **River Yare - East Bank – Pontoons Established**

Mariners are advised that Statoil have established a pontoon berth on the River Yare. The pontoon berth is 52 metres long and 2 metres wide located adjacent to the North end of Berth 9 and the South end of Berth 10 – between Port Marks 78 and 79.5.

The pontoons will be used to support the Construction, Operations and Maintenance of the Dudgeon Offshore Windfarm. The berth will be utilised by Windfarm Crew Transfer vessels running to the Windfarm from the Port of Great Yarmouth.

The pontoons are marked by two Fixed Green Navigation Lights in a Vertical Line mounted on poles at the Northern and Southern Extremities of the berth.

Northern Light Position: Lat. 52° 35.28' N, Long. 001° 43.42' E.

Southern Light Position: Lat. 52° 35.15' N, Long 001° 43.47' E.

Additionally, there is low level deck illumination of the pontoons along their length.
