LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**Flood Wall Repair Works – Berths 20 and
21A**

Mariners are advised that the Environment Agency will be undertaking repairs to the sheet piles on Bryants Wharf – Berths 20 and 21A – Port Marks 28 – 33.

The works will entail the use of a limpet dam, working platforms and other structures extending into the River Yare by up to 3 metres from the quay face. It is intended that the limpet dam will be removed from the water at the end of each working day, however, the working platform will remain suspended over the flood wall. Personnel will be working over-side at times during these works. The extreme limits of the work area will be marked by red flags and flashing amber lights. A safety boat will be operating in the area when personnel are working over the water.

Mariners are advised to keep well clear of the works and to pass with caution. Vessels must not be swung in the area without the permission of the Harbour Master. Contact should be made with Yarmouth Radio (VHF Channel 12) before berthing or un-berthing close to the works area.

During this time it may be necessary to close some of the berths in this area.

The work is scheduled to commence on 31st October 2016 and is expected to continue until the end of February 2017.
